


What is (E)JES Web?

- (E)JES Web is a browser-based interface to (E)JES implemented in Java. Our intent is to create a de facto interface to (E)JES for users that are uncomfortable navigating traditional 3270 interfaces.
- Through menu bars, context menus, and dialog boxes, (E)JES Web lets you monitor, manage, and control your z/OS JESplex.
- (E)JES Web supports all modern web browsers. This includes Google Chrome, Firefox, Opera, Safari, and Internet Explorer 8 or above.


Starting an (E)JES Web Session

Open your web browser and navigate to your site-specific (E)JES Web URL. Log in using your z/OS user name and password.



Starting an (E)JES Web Session


When you log in for the first time, the default display is the Status display. It is filtered by your Owner ID.



(E)JES Web Settings


You can change your filters and default display via dialog boxes. Your preferences are stored on the host and are used even when you log in from a different device or browser.





Issuing Line Commands

Line commands are accessible via a contextual menu when you right-click.



Using Dialog Boxes

Access dialog boxes via drop down menus. This is the Column Arrangement dialog box for the Status display.

Column Arrangement Drag and drop the column titles to hide, show, or order columns. Drag and **Hidden Columns** Visible Columns Width drop to JTYPE JobName arrange JNUM columns. 
Entering System Commands


System Command Output

Type






Type an F to display a search string field at the bottom of the display. Type G to find the next matching string.



Downloading Browse Data


Right-click anywhere on a browse display to download the data as text or a PDF.






(E)JES Web Help


